



Psalm 46:1-5

- 1 God is our refuge and strength,
an ever-present help in trouble.
- 2 Therefore we will not fear, though the earth give way
and the mountains fall into the heart of the sea,
3 though its waters roar and foam
and the mountains quake with their surging.
- 4 There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God,
the holy place where the Most High dwells.
- 5 God is within her, she will not fall;
God will help her at break of day.

The Goal of the Project: Each student creates an image (print), and or scene, in response to Psalm 46.

Materials Needed:

- Tape
- Pen
- Pencil
- Sharpie Marker
- Crayola Markers
- Sponge or wet paper towel
- Paper suggested size 3"x4"
- Styrofoam Plate cut into suggested size 3"x4"
- Cardstock/watercolor paper/or just computer paper 4"x5" used for the print.

Summary: Take a styrofoam plate and cut a 3"x4" rectangle piece out. Have student draw picture with pencil on 3"x4" paper. Make sure to draw using the entire paper. Take the paper and tape it on top of the styrofoam. Using a ballpoint pen press firm but do not puncture the paper but enough to leave an indentation. Once done, remove the paper. Take the sharpie marker and outline your indentation on the styrofoam rectangle. Next color with crayons marker all the area on the styrofoam rectangle. Put the styrofoam rectangle off to the side. Take the 4"x5" paper (cardstock/watercolor paper/or printing paper) with a wet sponge or

paper towel to dampen the paper. Lastly take the styrofoam rectangle and flip it down on the dampened paper. Press firmly all round. Then lift off to see your print!
