



## The Greatest Commandment & the Last Supper. Maundy Thursday. Creating Red Votive Candle Holders

### Materials Needed:

Mason Jar or something similar  
Red Acrylic (House Paint)  
Cup  
Drop Cloth  
Sharpie Marker  
Wire Coat Hanger  
Wire Cutters  
Candle

**Summary:** First, put your drop cloth down. Next, take your cup full of red paint and pour it in the Mason jar. Stir the paint all around so that it covers the whole jar. Once most of the inside is covered pour the rest of the paint back into the cup. Continue making sure most of the jar at the top is coated with paint then tip over on to the drop cloth so the excess paint will drip out this will ensure a thin coat. With the sharpie marker begin to put designs that remind you of this day, Maundy Thursday. Consider using the symbols on the next page. Next, take your wire coat hanger and the wire cutters and cut the wire in the middle (see the video). Then following the video use the wire to wrap around the mouth of the jar. Once the paint is dry wait for at least a day, put a candle in the jar and let an adult light the candle. Use your lantern for a Maundy Thursday Processional or hanging out on a tree on Thursday so neighbors can see and be reminded this is Holy Week.
